Identify a secondary school Point of Contact for students, foster parents, and child welfare agencies to ensure support and access during summer break, and to ensure that students are ready to begin school on time next fall.



Identify and connect students in foster care placement to programs and services available during the summer months. Make necessary referrals to ensure adequate support during summer break.
